

'Your Climate, Your Call' Schools Competition terms and conditions

1. Information on prizes and how to enter forms part of these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
2. The Promoter is Europe Direct Leeds represented for the purpose of this competition as Europe Direct Leeds, Central Library, Calverley Street, Leeds LS1 3AB
3. The competition commences on Friday June 5th 2009 and entries need to be received at Europe Direct Leeds, Central Library, Calverley Street, Leeds LS1 3AB by 5pm Friday 18th December 2009 MARKED YOUR CLIMATE, YOUR CALL and accompanied by the competition entry form. (No responsibility is accepted for lost, late, illegible or misdirected entries). Entry is open to primary school & secondary school students in years 3 to 9 who attend schools in Leeds
4. To enter the competition simply write a short story, essay, poem or rap lyrics, create a poster, painting or take a photograph (with a short description), telling us what climate change means to you.
5. All entries must be the sole work of the entrant(s).
6. All entries must use the official competition entry form to take part in this competition.
7. Entries will be judged in the following categories. Category 1: Primary School KS2 7-11 years. Category 2 : High School KS3 11-14 years
8. Participating students can work individually, or in teams.
9. Only one entry per student or group of students is permitted.
10. There are two prize categories:
 - a. Student. The most creative, well-written or visually effective student(s) entry in each category will win vouchers or book tokens up to the value of £500.
 - b. School. The most creative, well-written or visually effective student(s) entry from one Primary and one Secondary School in each category will win the school a digital camera.
11. All entrants will be invited to an exclusive celebratory event to be held in January 2010 at Leeds Museum, to launch Leeds Museum's new climate change exhibition.
12. A panel of judges drawn from Europe Direct Leeds, Leeds Museums, Education Leeds and Leeds City Council Sustainable Development Unit will determine the winning entries
13. Up to six entries will be shortlisted in each age category.
14. The winning entries will be announced on the Europe Direct Leeds website www.europedirectleeds.org.uk Tuesday 5th January 2010
15. All entries will be displayed in pdf format on Europe Direct Leeds website
16. The Judges' decision will be made between Saturday December 19th 2009 - Monday 4th January 2010 at Leeds Central Library
17. The winner(s) will be notified by phone and mail on Tuesday 5th January 2010
18. The Promoter may award a prize to another entrant if the original winner's prize remains unclaimed 3 months after the winner is announced.
19. The Judges and Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence regarding the winning entrants will be entered into. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and are not redeemable for cash. All entries become the property of the Promoter.
20. The Promoter, its contractors, employees and agents, will not be liable for any claims, losses, damages, injuries, costs and expenses suffered sustained, or incurred (including but not limited to indirect or consequential) as a result of, arising out of, or in any way connected with the competition and/or its prizes, except for liability that cannot be excluded by law. Tax implications may arise from the receipt or use of a prize. It is recommended that independent financial advice be obtained by the winners of the competition in respect of any tax implications arising from this competition.
